Initial Indoor Worship Service Reopening Guidelines

If you have been exposed to COVID-19, or even if you just don't feel well for any reason, we request that you stay home. During this season of uncertainty, please err on the side of caution for the protection of yourself and others. Also, if you feel more comfortable staying home, especially if you are in one of the higher risk groups, we support you. The online service will continue and we encourage you to take advantage of online fellowship. No one will think any less of those who make the decision to stay close to home and take other precautions at this time. It's a matter of sacrifice and thinking about the needs of others first.

The facility is being regularly cleaned.

We will have one service at 10:00am. Fellowship Hall will be used for overflow with video livestreaming.

All individuals two years and older will be required to wear a mask for the duration of the worship service. Those leading the service will wear a face mask when they are not speaking or singing. Attendees should bring their own face masks. A limited number of masks will be available for those who may not have one. We realize that children may struggle to wear masks perfectly, but we ask that parents provide masks or shields for children two years and older and give their best effort to help their children wear them.

Please plan to arrive early to be seated. Seating in the Worship Center is on a first come, first serve basis. Rows are spaced 6 feet apart from front to back. Please fill in from front to back. Overflow seating will be available in Fellowship Hall with video livestreaming.

The back rows will be reserved for our higher risk attendees so that they can be the last ones in and first ones out.

We ask that you practice social distancing while on church grounds. No handshakes, hugs, close contact, etc. We kindly ask parents to encourage the same with their children. Children will not be permitted to run or roam through the church building.

All are encouraged to use the restroom before leaving home. Please keep social distancing in mind in the restrooms and don't linger.

Doors will be propped open or held opened by greeters so that our congregation is not required to touch doorknobs or door bars.

We will provide printed bulletins but they are also available online by end of day on the the prior Friday.

Children's Church will be available for children from Pre-K 3 through 3rd grade during the sermon. Children will wear masks until they reach their seats in Rooms 103-104. Clipboards, writing instruments, and children's bulletins will be available for parents to pick up as they enter the Worship Center.

Four nursery rooms will be available for individual households on a first come, first serve basis. Rooms can be reserved ahead of time through the office. The service will be livestreamed into these rooms.

We will continue to use online and mail-in giving. Donations can be dropped in the box as you exit the Worship Center. There will be no passing of baskets.

Water fountains will be unavailable, so plan to bring water if needed.

Hand sanitizer stations will be available.

Special precautions will be taken for observing the Lord's Supper.

At the close of the service, you will be dismissed by rows from back to front. Please retreat outside where you will be free to socialize with socially distanced parameters.

If you have attended any church event or been on the church property, and have a confirmed case of COVID-19, a suspected case, or had exposure (close contact within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) to a confirmed/suspected case, we ask that you notify the church office. We will keep your identity confidential.
