**MISSIONARY OF THE MONTH: PHIL AND BARB - MTW** - Phil and Barb oversee evolving churches in SE Asia. Phil just completed a week’s teaching on the Old Testament to an island group and a week with folks in Sri Lanka. Pray that as they teach, preach, learn and further friendships that God will bless this ministry. Barb was assisted by her niece Brynn, and a RUF student group from Duke U. in an English camp for 83 refugees—the largest ever. The Rohingya women in her literacy group prepared a dinner for the students. She writes that everywhere you turn in this community, there is sorrow upon sorrow, but there was glorious light shining this week from the faces of those who live in the presence of Jesus. They are seeking 10 medical personnel and 4 trained counselors to assist the Presbyterian Church of Bangladesh for gospel ministry with a mental health focus among the Rohingya refugees who have experienced horrible trauma.
