Replace Flooring in Worship Center

Our desire is to be a church that would grow primarily from people coming to faith in Jesus rather than coming from another church. These enhancements will create an inviting atmosphere to build relationships with people in the community.



- New flooring will last much longer than carpet (25 year warranty vs 10-12 year of carpet)
- Easier to clean and repair if damaged (resilient)
- The new appearance will facilitate engagement with those who come
- Attractive to church visitors, students, preschool parents, and church activities (basketball, volleyball, and now pickleball!)

Sound and Lighting Enhancements

Adding side, spot, and focus lighting will allow the current house lights to be turned off during worship.



Individual lighting on the pastor, worship team, and speakers will provide a more focused atmosphere to the congregation as well as livestream viewers. Sound improvements throughout the worship center will reduce reverberations.

Secure Access

An electronically operated door will allow staff to push a button to allow someone in.

A CCTV camera and intercom will make it easy to address the outside person.

Digital access will replace physical keys for main exterior doors.

With the number of children attending preschool, parents will feel more comfortable and Cornerstone will be inviting as a whole.



Build a Storage Facility and Outdoor Activity Area

30' x 48' structure will be a permanent facility to store equipment with security and readily accessible.

24' x 48' extended roof over a concrete pad will furnish picnic tables for students and Life Groups.



Electric, water, and network connectivity will facilitate more gathering at the fire pit.

Outdoor activities will be seen as popular and inviting to the community.

New Sign for Front Lawn

LED sign facing south down 896 will have adequate size and will be easy to read.

Images and text will be able to be created from office and will display upcoming events, reminders, and invitations to our website to motorists who pass by.

Another smaller lighted sign will face north and only have our church name.
