2025 Bible Memory Plan: Instead of a Bible *reading* plan, this year we are embarking on a Bible *memory* plan. Through the year, we will be working through 60 different verses which were originally laid out in the Navigator's "Topical Memory System." Missionary of the Month

Donnie and Kara, Missions To The World

Donnie and Kara work with the West Africa Church in a predominately Muslim context. Donnie assists in preparing men as future pastors and works with existing leaders' new initiatives. Kara works with the wives of pastors in discipling the women and children of the church. Donnie and Kara also help connect international churches with West African churches. Together they coordinate logistics and make arrangements for visiting partners and colleagues. The Timothy House is forefront in the training of pastors in Senegal and Donnie works with the graduates of Timothy House as they go through the ordination process and work on establishing churches. He assists Pastor Moustapha and his wife Monique with a new church plant, Malikounda. Kara teaches a weekly ESL class on behalf of and at the request of Moustapha as part of the church plant.

Prayer Requests:

- Pray for the church in Senegal along with Pastor Moustapha and Pastor Edouard as they navigate the currents of culture, that both national believers and we foreign workers will increasingly absorb and model the values of God's kingdom more than the early kingdoms we were born into.
- Pray for the RUF Global Training in the Gambia and three very gifted team of three pastors and a young woman lay-leader who are spearheading the RUF Global work there through the Presbyterian Church of The Gambia.
