## 2025 BIBLE MEMORY PLAN:

## Missionary of the Month

### Donnie and Kara, Missions To The World

Donnie and Kara have served with Mission to the World (MTW) in West Africa since 2014. They work alongside the Presbyterian Church of Senegal (l'Église Presbytérienne du Sénégal or EPS) in a predominantly Muslim context. Their recent and primary focus has been assisting two pastors and their wives in the planting of a church in a predominantly unreached vicinity about an hour and a half down the coast from the capital city of Dakar. Donnie also serves as MTW team leader and travels inland to assist potential and more established rural pastors through the Timothy House training. Kara teaches EFL classes both through the church plant and to a group at a nearby engineering ministry. Together they work closely with Jim and Karen and their other teammates. Before moving to West Africa, Donnie was an associate pastor at Trinity PCA in Asheville, NC, which is their home base. Prior to that, they started the Reformed University Fellowship at the Savannah College of Art & Design. Their three young adult children and spouses reside in the vicinity of Western North Carolina.

- For Donnie and Kara's ongoing friendships and working relationships with Moustapha, Monique, Edouard and Camille, who are planting the church.
- For their weekly meetings: Donnie with these pastors, honing their hermeneutical skills among other things; Kara with the EFL classes, that they would increase the vocational capacity of believers and serve as a conduit for the church among nonbelievers.
